## ASIA

### Japan

*January 24*

We spent our day with the saints in Western Tokyo sharing our enjoyment of the all-inclusive Christ as the good land and preaching the gospel at a train station. We concluded our day with the prayer meeting in Tokyo.

Prayer burdens:

1. That the Spirit would continue to speak to the ones that received a tract.
2. That the Lord would bless the gospel meeting on January 28 and release His burden through the testimonies.
3. That the young people would be preserved to join the Full-time Training in Tokyo.

## EUROPE

### Baltic Countries (Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania)

*January 24*
