AFRICA

Ethiopia

February 1

Germany (Frankfurt)

January 31

Baltic Countries (Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania)

February 1

We have spent the past three days in Riga, Latvia where we have been joining the local saints in their labor at Riga Technical University (RTU). Many of the students at RTU have called on the Lord, prayed with us, are open to the truths in the ministry, and are hungry for Christian fellowship. On February 2, we will have a gospel outreach at the University of Latvia and on February 3 we will have a time with the young people.
