

# 2024 FTTA Gospel Trips Report and Prayer Burdens 12 February 2, 2024

## ASIA

## Singapore

### *February 1*

Today, half of us went to Singapore Institute of Management (SIM) to have a Bible study on campus while the other half went to the National University of Singapore (NUS) to pass out invitations to the campus gospel meeting in the evening. At the gospel meeting, there were 63 people in attendance, 9 of whom came for the first time. The trainee brothers shared a gospel message on the Mystery of Human Life and the trainee sisters shared their testimonies. At the end of the time, 3 people received the Lord, and 3 people were baptized. Another person expressed the desire to be baptized after recovering from their surgery in two weeks.

From February 2-4, there will be a church conference held in Singapore and the saints are excited to participate and be under the rich speaking of the Lord.

# Japan

## *February 1*

Some of the team visited gospel contacts in their home and fellowshiped about calling on the name of the Lord, then had lunch with the saints and new ones at the University of Tokushima before finishing the day with dinner with the saints and overflowing our enjoyment of the past week.

The rest of the team was in Osaka and split between two different train stations to preach the gospel. The sisters also joined several appointments with students and local saints. A highlight of the time was when a gospel friend student prayed to receive the Lord, sang, called on the Lord, and fellowshiped with us at the meeting hall afterward.

## *February 2*

Departed Tokushima/ Osaka and arrived in Kobe. Enjoyed a time of blending over dinner with the saints in Kobe.

# EUROPE

## Poland (Warsaw)

### *February 1*

We preached the gospel at the University of Life Sciences (SGGW) and had appointments with contacts from the past two weeks. We passed out 59 tracts, 2 Bibles, and had 7 conversations, and 3 appointments. In the evening, some of us joined the young people's meeting.

### *February 2*

We went in two teams to the cities of Poznan and Łódź. In Poznan we met with a brother and had fellowship regarding some encouraging contacts. In Łódź we tabled, preached the gospel, and met with positive contacts from a previous gospel trip. Two people left us their contact information. Later we attended a home meeting where new ones from tabling came.

Prayer burdens:

1. For the shepherding of the positive contacts in Poznan and Łódź. Particularly, there is a couple in Poznan who is reading the ministry with a brother here, and in Łódź we are hoping to see one of the gospel contacts from today a second time this weekend.
2. To contact new ones in these cities this weekend and gain at least one remaining fruit in each city.

# Dublin (Ireland)

*January 31*

The Ireland team spent several hours on the campus of University Dublin College (UCD) on January 30-31. We have enjoyed praying as a team and with the saints for the people of Ireland, especially that the Lord would open and soften the hearts of some young Irish students.

The Ireland team spent February 1-2 on the campus of Trinity College Dublin (TCD). On this campus we've been able to hand out tracts and Bibles liberally, as well as have many meaningful conversations.

Tomorrow (February 3) we will join the saints for an outing with the YP and will join the YP meeting and dinner together.

## Mid-Atlantic

Another group of trainees attended a home meeting with Spanish-speaking saints in Phoenix. Both times were full of encouragement. Before the Thursday night ministry message was given, we had an opportunity to speak with the students who came for dinner. One student shared with us his testimony of how he came to the Lord and the club, and greatly encouraged us.
