

2024 FTTA Gospel Trips Report and Prayer Burdens 15 February 5, 2024

ASIA

Philippines

February 2

The church in Taguig hosted a series of gospel meetings for the students from a nearby school. Over 1,300 students attended. Many prayed to receive the Lord and 28 expressed their desire to be baptized. Praise the Lord!

February 4

On Lord's day, February 4, we had a combined meeting with the churches in Southern Metro Manila (SMM). In the afternoon, we joined the SMM young people's meeting. We were able to share our experiences on how the Lord brought us to the training as well as our highlights from the training. In the evening, we visited a trainee's family and overflowed our enjoyment from the gospel trip.

Prayer Burdens:

1. That the Lord would grant the saints grace to shepherd the 28 students who expressed interest in being baptized, and that the students' parents' would approve of their baptism.
2. For the young people in SMM to be open to come to the training.
3. For the establishing of small groups to perfect the saints in SMM for the carrying out of the Lord's ordained way.

EUROPE

Italy

February 2-4

We spent our last 4 days of the gospel trip with the saints in Milan.

On Friday, February 2, we preached the gospel at the University of Milan-Bicocca, which is located near the meeting hall. Several local saints joined us to preach the gospel on the campus. We handed out tracts and Bibles, and had many conversations with students. One student and a couple prayed to receive the Lord and some came to the meeting that evening!

On Saturday, February 3, we had an outing with the young people and college students at Lake Lecco, followed by dinner in the homes with the saints. An exchange student from Spain joined us and was very touched when we shared our testimonies, and she also shared her experience of regeneration and her

relationship with the Lord with us. On the train ride back, we spontaneously started to sing which attracted a young missionary to come talk to us. We invited him to join us for dinner at a local saint's home where we had over 3 hours of wonderful fellowship and mutual encouragement. We gave him a Recovery version Bible.

On Lord's Day, February 4, we went to the Lord's table meeting in Milan. There were around 70 saints including some visiting from China and nearby localities. It was very encouraging to praise the Lord in Italian, Chinese, and English. There is one Body in this universe! After the meeting, we had a love feast where we heard the testimonies of some saints and had sweet fellowship. Afterwards, we explored the city with some students and local saints. We also met up with a brother's classmate. It is so encouraging that he is burdened to introduce his classmates to the saints. The last few days of the gospel trip were filled with mutual encouragement and an expanded vision of the Body.

Prayer Burdens:

1. For the increase of the local churches in Italy specifically by gaining the local Italian people.
2. For the follow up with those we met over these 2 weeks and that all those who received a tract or Bible would read them and be brought to the Lord.
3. For the translation and publishing of the Holy Word for Morning Revival in Italian as well as the translation of the Recovery version in Italian for the future.
4. That the Lord would thrust out more workers to migrate to Italy to join and strengthen the local saints in preaching the gospel of the Kingdom.
5. That the Lord would have a strong testimony in this key European country to shame His enemy for His return.



NORTH AMERICA

Canada: Greater Vancouver

February 1-2

On Thursday, February 1, we all participated in the main weekly Bible study at the University of British Columbia campus. The students that joined were very seeking and participated eagerly. In the Bible study, we covered John chapter 14 and matters related to the Triune God, Christ being the Spirit, His making His

home in our hearts, and how to practically apply this word. Later, we traveled to Langley and had dinner and fellowship with local saints, followed by spending time with our hospitality.

On Friday, February 2, we visited nine different homes and additional families joined in the visitation. These times were filled with fellowship and blending.

February 3

On Saturday, February 3, we continued the visitations in the homes. The response from the saints who have opened their homes has been very positive. The visits have been enjoyable and encouraging and always ended with prayer.

In the afternoon, we attended the quarterly blending meeting of the young people and college students in the Greater Vancouver Area. Including the parents and serving ones, 170 were in attendance. The topic of the time was full-time training. After a time of singing, we watched the videos: "What is the training?" and "Why the training?" Then the current Full-Time Training in Anaheim (FTTA) trainees spoke on the four pillars of the training. In addition, four graduated trainees shared their testimony of going to the training before some brothers spoke a confirming word to conclude the speaking.

Afterward, the young people and college students were asked to stand up and consecrate themselves if they had even a slight feeling for attending the full-time training, and 32 young people and college students stood up. This was accompanied with prayer for the consecration of these ones. We ended the day with small group meetings in Langley.

February 4

In total, we visited 18 homes in Langley, BC. These visits were very encouraging and supplying for all of us. In the Lord's Day meeting, we shared our highlights from the past two weeks of the gospel trip. In the evening, we joined the Church Service fellowship in Vancouver.

Prayer Burdens:

1. For the encouragement of the saints and the strengthening of the Lord's testimony in Langley.
2. For 30 saints to attend the prayer meetings in Langley regularly.
3. For the college students from all over Canada who will attend FTFA short-term in May 2024.
4. That the Lord would honor the young people and college students' consecrations and their burden to be trained, even that many more from Canada would be able to be sent to attend FTFA.
5. That the saints in Vancouver would be touched by the fellowship and enter into the burden of the church service.

Southeast

Georgia / Tennessee

February 2

We held a children's time this morning with about 19 boys and girls between the ages of 2 to 7. We sang children's songs with them, keeping the children engaged by having them help us with the hand motions. Our emphasis was that God created all the animals and the plants. Afterwards, we had snacks and engaged
