January 14, 2026

EUROPE

Italy (Bologna)

January 10

We had coordination in the morning and went out on the gospel for one last time in Bologna. Since it was Saturday, we did not go to the university but labored instead at Piazza Maggiore and Piazza Minghetti. We had a strong feeling to give out all the remaining materials, desiring that every tract, booklet, and Bible would be sown as a seed. By the Lord's mercy, we were able to distribute all the remaining tracts. We trust that the Lord will use these seeds to reach many seeking ones in Bologna and in the surrounding cities.

January 11

On Lord's Day, we traveled back to Milan and joined the Lord's table meeting with the saints there. Although there were some delays with the trains, it was sweet to travel together and care for one another. We were supplied by the testimonies of Christ and enjoyed the sweet fellowship with the saints.

After the meeting, we had a love feast and a time of blending. In the evening, we gathered for an overflow meeting in which the Bologna and Turin teams each presented their reports. The reports were full of enjoyment and appreciation for the Lord's move. We also received a further word concerning the burden for Europe, Italy, and the specific cities visited during this trip. Although it was difficult to say goodbye to the saints we were built with, we are thankful for the Christ gained together and trust that the Lord will continue what He has begun.

Italy (Turin)

January 8-9

On Thursday, we started off our day with corporate prayer and coordination, continuing to pray for our contacts. Later that day we had dinner in the homes where we received wonderful fellowship with the local saints. On Friday, many saints had appointments with previous contacts. Some saints were in Genoa for the fourth round of Italy gospel trips, so we went out with them for tabling near the university. We ended the night with much blending, with some in the local saints' homes and some eating out together.

January 10

From Thursday to Saturday, eight saints went to visit Genoa, the sixth largest city in Italy, where there are a small number of saints living. They were able to meet with these saints to encourage them and also spend time on the gospel and distributing the ministry.

On Saturday, in Turin, we spent some time coordinating about how we would follow up with the 30+ persons that we met throughout the week. We were also able to have our last tabling time during which a college student approached the table who was so open and desperate to have fellowship with us. He received an English Recovery Version Bible and an Italian Bible. He was also interested in attending the Lord's Day meeting the next day.

Two groups of saints drove over an hour to the cities of Cuneo and Biella to meet with the small group of saints there in their homes. It was a wonderful time of blending and fellowship. Two other groups of saints remained behind in Turin to follow up with some of the ones we have met this week. The first group of saints met with a mother and her two daughters in their home. After this time, the mother and a daughter were brought to a saint's home to be baptized in their bathtub!

The other group of saints invited some of the university students for a gathering in one of the saints' homes. Although we had several meetings with these students during the week, this was the first time for them to be in a home of the saints. One of the students was baptized! We were so encouraged by these baptisms. What a glory to the Lord and a shame to the enemy!

January 11

On Lord's Day morning, we had our last meeting with the saints in Turin before returning to Milan for the overflow meeting with the team in Bologna. We expect that the Lord will continue to do superabundantly above all that we ask or think in Turin during the next round of gospel trips and the subsequent gospel trip visitations this year.
