Report and Prayer Burdens 11

January 25, 2026

EUROPE

Germany (Berlin)

January 22

We traveled to Berlin in the morning and, upon arrival, went to a saints' home for lunch and fellowship. In the evening, we attended the Christian Students event, where a brother shared a message on Christ as the new wine and the new wineskin. Following the message, we broke into smaller groups for further fellowship and overflow. We were encouraged by the students' sharing, their portions of Christ, and their thoughtful answers.

January 23

In the morning, we were in coordination, covering *Fellowshipping with the Lord for the Mingling of God with Man*. Afterward, the brothers met a student for a shepherding appointment, while the sisters joined the full-time serving sisters at a museum, followed by lunch fellowship. In the evening, we divided into pairs for small group meetings: one group studied Video Training Message 12, another shepherded a new one in a home meeting, and a third fellowshipped and shared testimonies with a family, giving further opportunities to blend with the local saints.

January 24

We went on a day trip to Halle and Leipzig with the college students and the full-time team. On the train rides, during meals, and throughout our travels, it was encouraging to see the blending and building even among the college students and the full-time team. Several groups shared their testimonies and asked questions concerning the training.

Prayer burdens:

1. That the students would be simple and enjoy Christ as the new wine and the church life as the new wineskin.
2. For the salvation and recovery of the ones that the saints have been laboring on.



Germany (Düsseldorf)

January 24

Several local saints and young people joined us to table and preach the gospel at the city center in Essen. We handed out 82 tracts and 14 Bible sets. We have been having dinner with different local families, and we were very encouraged to hear how the Lord brought them to Germany to continue His move in Europe.

January 25

The couple we met through the gospel came to the table meeting! We were so encouraged, and they enjoyed it very much. We are looking forward to another appointment this upcoming week. On January 26th to January 27th, we will be tabling at Heinrich Heine University (HHU) in Düsseldorf for the first time.

Prayer burdens:

1. For proper follow up with the five new students that came to the Bible study.
2. For the Lord to open the hearts of many students in HHU and bring us to His chosen ones as He did in Essen.
3. For the blending of the trainees with the local saints especially in our preaching of the gospel and shepherding of the new contacts.



Germany (Hamburg)

January 23

Today was our first day on campus. We were split into two teams, to go to Hochschule für Angewandte Wissenschaften Hamburg (HAW) and to the University of Hamburg. Several students were quite open and even expressed that they would like to join a Bible study or would be open to meeting again.

January 24

On Saturday, we went out into the community in two groups, to a train station and to a shopping center. Most of our time was spent handing out tracts. We ended the night at a Ukrainian family's home, where we had fellowship concerning how they came into the church life and how they are adjusting to their life in Hamburg. We also had time to pray for their son, who is in the midst of applying and deciding where to go for university.

January 25

We had our first table meeting here in Hamburg, with around 40 saints, along with a love feast. The saints prophesied on their experience and the need to have a hidden life with the Lord for the Lord to go deeper in them. We ended the night in the homes of the saints, having fellowship concerning their experience of serving the Lord and what brought them to Hamburg.

Italy (Padua)

January 23

After coordination and preaching the gospel at the University of Padua, we had the Friday gospel dinner. Seven students attended in total. Among them were some contacts of the local saints, as well as three flatmates we had met earlier in the week, who had been quite open to the saints. We fellowshipped with these three concerning religion versus a relationship with Christ. At the end, they asked for the saints' numbers to keep in touch.

January 24

The three saints who traveled to Trieste returned. After having dinners with the saints there on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday and preaching the gospel in the city with some of the saints, the saints in Trieste were very refreshed and encouraged by their visitation. In the evening, we had a student dinner in the saints' home. There were 36 of us in total, including ten newer ones who had had a little contact with the local saints before. Eight of the ten were local Italians.

January 25

In the morning, we went to the Lord's table/prophesying meeting in Vicenza. Afterwards, we went to Milan to have a gospel trip report meeting with the subteams from Vicenza and Turin. Through the reports, we were all very encouraged by what the Lord is doing and will continue to do in Italy.

Canada

Calgary, AB / Edmonton, AB / Lethbridge, AB

January 20

The local saints in Lethbridge and trainees distributed Bibles and ministry books at the University of Lethbridge. In total, 17 New Testaments and 23 ministry books were distributed, and we met many dear believers as well as ones who were open to knowing more about God. We thank the Lord for His Word reaching people in Alberta and for the sweet fellowship with the local saints.

Prayer burdens:

1. That the Lord would continue to feed, draw, and gain people in Alberta through His Word.
2. That the local saints in Lethbridge would be encouraged and refreshed through the fellowship and by looking unto Jesus.
3. For the upcoming Bible distribution on January 27th at the University of Alberta, that many would be open and receive the Word.



Mountain States Colorado

January 20

The trainees, full-time team, and a couple of community saints preached the gospel for the first time this trip at Auraria Campus, which serves over 50,000 students across three schools. The Christians on Campus club is active at the University of Colorado Denver, and students from the other colleges also participate. Many students were open to longer conversations and shared their contact information.

January 21

We went back to Auraria Campus for gospel preaching. Most of the students commute, and either have class on Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays. We were able to hand out more Bibles than the previous days, and were also joined by some students. We had dinner in the homes and joined the prayer meeting afterwards.

January 22

The team went to Arapahoe Community College to distribute Bibles. There has not been much labor on this campus, but many students were happy to receive Bibles. Afterwards, we traveled to Colorado Springs and blended with the local families over dinner.

January 23

There are currently no full-timers serving in Colorado Springs, but we had coordination with one community saint who joined us for Bible distribution at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs (UCCS) campus. It snowed the entire day, but the team handed out an average of one Bible per minute! In the evening, we joined the young people and young adults meeting.
