Report and Prayer Burdens 14

January 28, 2026

EUROPE

Germany (Düsseldorf)

January 26

Today we went to Heinrich-Heine University Düsseldorf (HHU) and set up two tables; one at the campus bus station and another at the campus train station. Local saints joined our coordination and our going out. We gave out approximately 15 tracts, contacted nine students, and gave out nine Bibles. We had dinner with a local family. We were very blessed to fellowship with them and shared short testimonies about how we came to the Full-Time Training.

January 27

We went to HHU again today, this time without a table, and found students to speak to. We then had lunch at the cafeteria and sat down with students to speak with them. In the evening we had dinner with one of the local families and fellowshiped about why we came to Europe for our gospel trips. We also joined the church-wide prayer meeting and entered into the church prayer burdens with the saints.

Prayer burdens:

1. For the proper follow up and shepherding for the ones we contacted in Essen, Germany, especially the five that came to the Bible study. We are planning to meet up with two tomorrow (1/29) and possibly with the young couple again this weekend.
2. For the Lord to soften the ground at HHU and lead us to the sons of peace.
3. For the blending and coordination of the trainees with the local saints especially in our preaching of the gospel and the shepherding of the new contacts.

Germany (Hamburg)

January 26

In the evening we attended the English-speaking Bible study meeting with around twenty in attendance. During the time, we went over Ephesians 1, on the Triune God being dispensing into us and wrought into our being. After going through the chapter on how the Triune God dispensed into us is to accomplish seven crucial things, we split into three groups to share our experience on receiving God's dispensing and how God's dispensing can be in our daily experience.

January 27

In the morning we spent time praying for the ones we have contacted. We then went to continue our labor on the Hamburg University of Applied Sciences (HAW) and University of Hamburg campuses. We reconnected with some who had passed by before and even a couple that have no Christian background and who are very seeking. In the evening we attended the prayer meeting.

We prayed for the gospel dinner this Saturday, for the Lord to continue to dispense Himself into the saints, for the Lord to add a couple or two brothers to the full-time team, and for the Lord to guide the saints in looking for a new meeting place.

January 28

Today we had a German Bible study at the meeting hall. One of the new contacts we contacted a few days ago joined this time who was raised in Hamburg and attending HAW. This one was very open and hungry for the word and for fellowship. During the Bible study, we also had a team go out to continue our labor at University of Hamburg.

Ireland

January 25

We joined the saints in Dublin for the Lord's table meeting, which also was comprised of saints from Cork and other parts of Ireland. Afterward, we joined the young people's meeting with about fifteen young people in Dublin.

January 26

The trainees went to spread the gospel on Trinity College Dublin, both the brothers and sisters were also joined by students from the university. We were able to hand out many tracts both in the university and surrounding tourist areas. In the evening, we joined the Chinese speaking saints for dinner and fellowship.

January 27

We spent most of the day at University College of Dublin (UCD) for the spreading of the gospel. This is the largest university in Ireland and we were able to meet many local Irish. Afterward we attended the prayer meeting, praying and fellowshiping over the ones we met at the university that day.

Prayer burdens:

Poland

January 25-27

On Lord's Day, we had the Lord's table in Warsaw, and then drove to Gdańsk for a home meeting. On Monday and Tuesday, we had coordination and then preached the gospel and tabled at the University of Gdańsk. During this time, we also had an appointment with one of the regular students. In the evenings, we had a "Pizza Connect." On Monday evening, one new one came, J, and we sang and shared our experience of the Lord being a friend of sinners. On Tuesday evening, two new ones came, C and V, and we shared our top revelation of the Training.

Prayer burdens:

1. For the Lord to bring the sons of peace in Gdańsk and to shepherd the new contacts.
2. For saints to migrate to Gdańsk so that a lampstand can be raised up.



Spain

January 24–25

We had a day trip to Valladolid where we explored the city with some saints, then joined the blending meetings with the young people from Madrid, Valladolid, and Bilbao. Valladolid does not have a lampstand yet, but they rented a children's gathering place for the meeting.

January 26-27

In the morning, we had some college students and young people join us for corporate pursuit. We were not able to table outside due to the heavy rain. We had a home meeting that night.

January 28

We traveled to Malaga in the south of Spain and joined them for the prayer meeting. The saints are burdened for the two cities in the south of Spain, Granada, and Cordoba.

Prayer burdens:

1. That the young people in Madrid would continue to pursue with their companions.
2. For the weather in Malaga to not hinder us from going out for gospel preaching and tabling.
3. For the gospel preaching on campus in Malaga on Thursday.
4. For the gospel preaching and visitation to Cordoba on Saturday.

NORTH AMERICA

Mountain States

Albuquerque, NM / Tempe, AZ / Flagstaff, AZ

January 25

The church in Flagstaff held their second table meeting at Northern Arizona University (NAU), which was their first table meeting on campus. Around nine students joined us and some even prophesied. In the evening, the church got together and had a very sweet testimony and prayer time.

January 26

Before leaving Flagstaff, we had some fellowship with the students at Northern Arizona University. Later, we traveled to Tempe and the saints warmly welcomed us at the hall for a time of dinner and introductions.

January 27

On our first full day in Tempe, we preached the gospel and had a table for the Christian club at Arizona State University (ASU). One student and one visiting high schooler called on the Lord! Later, we had a Bible study with four returning students and enjoyed the matter of the church and God's dispensing in Ephesians.
