February 4, 2026

EUROPE

Düsseldorf / Essen

February 1

In the morning we enjoyed a sweet Lord's table and a rich prophesying meeting with the saints at the meeting hall in Düsseldorf followed by a corporate love feast. In the evening a local family hosted us for dinner, and we enjoyed hearing their testimonies and spending time with their toddler daughter. Then later in the evening we met with two new ones for an appointment in which we enjoyed such a sweet fellowship and were all very supplied and encouraged after the time.

February 2

In the morning the saints prepared breakfast for us at the meeting hall as a final send-off, and we all shared our top highlights from these past two weeks in Düsseldorf and Essen. Afterwards the saints took us to the train station. We traveled for the rest of the day before arriving at Berlin in the evening where we had a rich overflow meeting with all the gospel teams in the Germany hub.

February 3

We drove from Kraków to Warsaw to have the final overflow meeting. Alongside the Baltic team, we shared our recap of the trip with the saints.

NORTH AMERICA

Canada

Calgary, AB / Edmonton, AB / Lethbridge, AB

January 28

The trainees and full-timers traveled to Red Deer to visit and blend with the saints there, enjoying a sweet time of fellowship and a corporate reading that evening. We were deeply encouraged by the testimony of the saints, especially seeing some commute over an hour to blend due to the absence of a lampstand or local group meetings.

January 29

The trainees, serving ones, and local saints in Calgary went out for a Bible distribution at the University of Calgary. A total of 62 New Testament Bibles were distributed along with ministry books and gospel tracts, and several students were open and interested in further contact. Several current students stopped to fellowship, which was very encouraging.

Prayer burdens:

1. For the establishment and strengthening of the home meetings in Fort McMurray, Ponoka, and Red Deer.
2. That the Lord would increase the traffic and blending among the saints in these smaller localities.
3. For proper follow-up with those who received the 62 Bibles, that there would be remaining fruit and that the Lord would add to the church.
4. That the next generation on campus would be preserved in the church, captured and strengthened by the Lord, and become seeds of the gospel.

Mountain States

Colorado

January 28

The trainees traveled from Fort Collins to Greeley. The church in Greeley currently meets in a home, and much of their increase has come through friends and family. We had coordination with the local saints and then went to the University of Northern Colorado to distribute Bibles. Although there has been little labor on this campus, the team distributed all the English Bibles that were brought and had contact with 41 students. In the evening, we had a blending dinner with the saints in Greeley and fellowshiped concerning the Bible distribution before returning to Fort Collins.

January 29

On their final day in Fort Collins, the trainees divided into two groups to distribute Bibles at Front Range Community College and in a downtown area. The reception at the community college was very positive, and the team ran out of Bibles in less than an hour. After lunch, the trainees traveled to north Denver and concluded the day with dinner at their hospitality.

January 30

For the final gospel time of the trip, the trainees gathered in north Denver and went to the University of Colorado Boulder to distribute Bibles. There is currently no campus work there, as few saints live in the area. A total of 30 saints came out, and nearly 200 Bibles were distributed. We ate lunch together at the campus dining hall and ended the day with a home meeting.

January 31

On the final full day, the trainees blended with the saints. In the evening, there was a full-time training fellowship in Denver with the young people and college students. Each trainee shared briefly concerning how the Lord brought them to the full-time training and their experience in it.
