## EUROPE

### Italy (Rome)

*February 4*

We started our day by coordinating with the saints in Rome at the meeting hall. Due to rain, we split into two teams going to two cafeterias on the campus of Sapienza University of Rome. We sat down with students in pairs and had conversations while having lunch. During lunch time, the saints are able to have longer conversations with the students. Some students exchanged contact information with us at the end of the time. Some saints went to a bus stop to have short conversations with students.

The sisters went to have dinner at a saint's home and had sweet fellowship with a student. The student asked to accompany the sisters after the gospel activity tomorrow for touring around the city.

*February 5*

Today more than half of the saints went to have appointments with the students. The rest of us tabled near the Sapienza University of Rome again. Many students come to this spot everyday since it's close to campus. One student actively listened to the gospel and received a tract from a brother. A brother met a young one on the street and preached the gospel to him. The young one called upon the name of the Lord and prayed to receive the Lord. Two brothers went to have lunch with a student, who turned out to be really curious about the difference between the spirit and soul. The two brothers introduced him to the tract ("Hai Mangiato Bene" — Have You Eaten Well) and The Mystery of Human Life. He was really positive about this appointment and is open to having another appointment with the brothers.

Three sisters had lunch with a student from China, who is a believer from China. She told the sisters that she only knows concerning "the knowledge of right and wrong", but here we are focusing on "life", thus, she is attracted by it and wants to meet with us.

*February 6*

We started our day by enjoying the ministry. We enjoyed Dan. 11:32 and that the spread of the gospel is not by work but by emigration. Although we may consider we are small, the Lord's Word can be spread through us.

The saints noticed the flow of the traffic on the pedestrian way was smaller than usual. It turned out this is because the exam system was hacked and they cannot schedule the exams. This caused a lot of change in the students' schedule during finals season. Some students even are not able to join the meeting with us. We decided to change the tabling location to a crosswalk near a dining hall. The flow of traffic was much more than

we expected. Many stopped and listened to our singing. We even drew attention from people in the parking lot behind us. The brothers noticed that two hymns were more attracting: “The Year of Jubilee” and “Blessed Assurance”. Due to the new location, the saints had more time to preach the gospel to the ones that were interested. Some students continued to talk to us despite the light having changed a few times. Some even called upon the Lord’s name and prayed to receive the Lord with us. The saints were encouraged by the openness of the students.

That night we went to have dinner and fellowship at a saint’s home. Many college students came to join us for dinner. It was a sweet time of blending, and the students had recently started to meet with the saints. The saints hope to establish a weekly meeting with the college students.
